Subject: Germantown Road at Wolf River Blvd Intersection Improvements

Dear Mr. Hurst:

The Memphis MPO has determined that the requested Adjustment #43 to the FY 2014-17 TIP meets the criteria to be processed as an administrative adjustment and not as an amendment. As a result, there was no public notice of the changes and no vote by the Transportation Policy Board to approve the changes.

The City of Germantown has requested to adjust the FY 2014-17 TIP by adding \$390,720 in Surface Transportation Program (STP) Federal Funds and \$97,680 in state funds for the ROW phase and moving all ROW funds to FY 2016 for the Germantown Road at Wolf River Blvd Intersection Improvements project, #STP-M-2014-07. The changes are for existing TIP projects, the adjustment does not change the project scope, and the funding changes meet the thresholds established for an adjustment under the Memorandum of Agreement between TDOT and the MPO. Since the TIP is a subset of the 2040 L RTP then air quality conformity determination made on the RTP applies to the TIP (40 CFR 93.122).

The Memphis MPO has made the requested adjustment to the Memphis MPO's FY 2014-17 TIP to accurately reflect the requested changes. It is the request of the Memphis MPO that the TIP project changes be amended into the State of Tennessee Statewide Transportation Improvement Plan. Attached to this letter are the old and newly adjusted TIP pages.

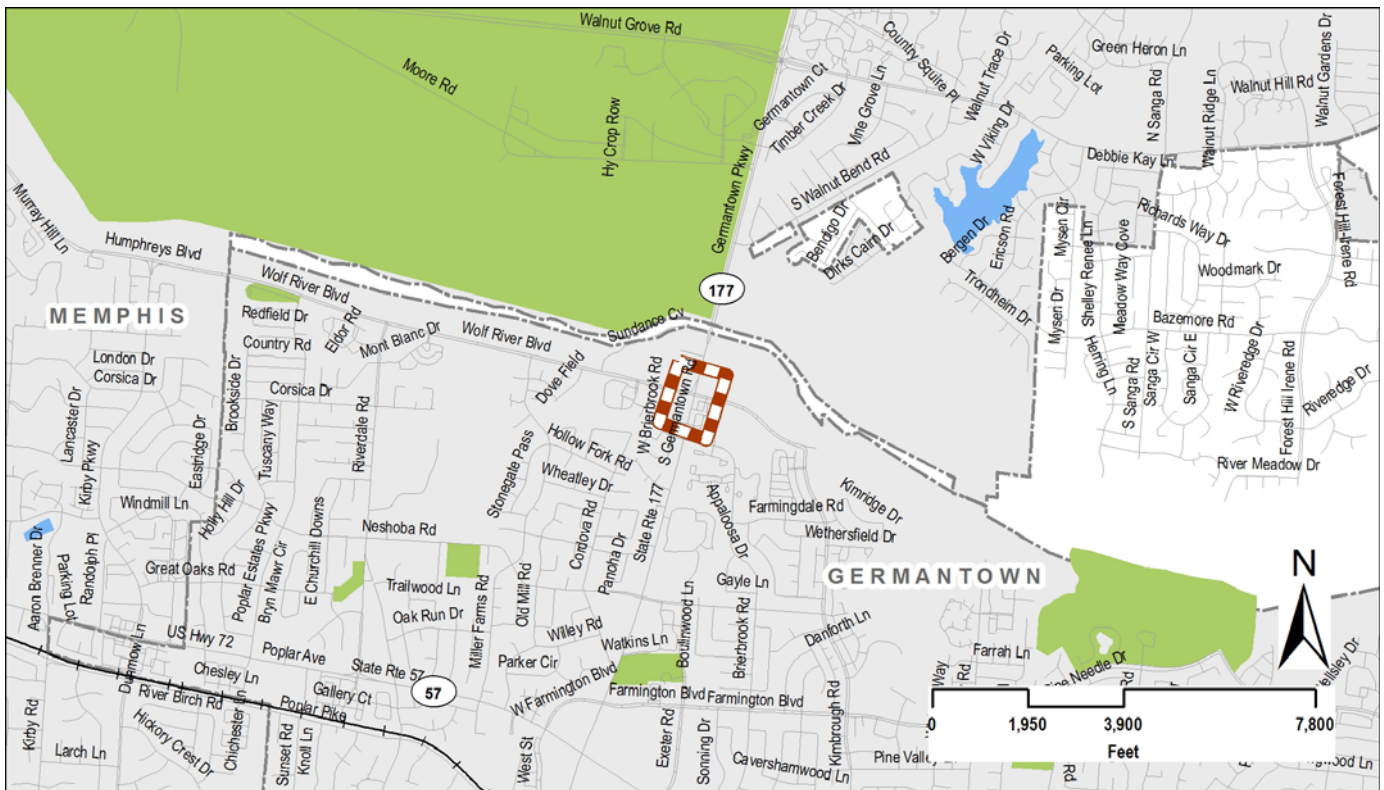
